



Uranium Drive-In is the story of an economically devastated rural mining community in southwestern Colorado that finds itself hopeful for the first time in decades. Their potential salvation? Returning to the "glory" days of the past, uranium mining and milling.

The film follows three main characters: Tami Lowrance, Mayor of Naturita and strong proponent of the mill; Ayngel Overson, struggling mother of four who longs for the survival of her town but has mixed feelings about the mill; and Jennifer Thurston, an environmental activist fighting to stop the mill.

The team behind the investigation returns, tracks down the illegal circuses, and saves every animal. The confrontations, heartache and incredible risks the rescue team face. are all captured before a joyous finale sees 25 lions airlifted to freedom in Colorado.

Lion Ark is an uplifting story of bravery, compassion, camaraderie and determination, and shows how a poor but proud country said "no" to cruelty, and how attitudes to animals were changed across an entire continent.

Master Debaters also introduces us to a series of Black and Hispanic Urban Debate League superstars, two of whom defy all odds to defeat the top debate team in the country at the National Forensic League Nationals in Salt Lake City.

But Master Debaters is not just a feel-good story of triumph over adversity. Debate is a game; the same game played by CEOs, trial lawyers, and political candidates who will trade in what they believe for what they know will win.

Master Debaters asks us to examine what kind of people debaters become when they are asked to defend positions that are at best preposterous, and, at worst, morally reprehensible.






